Knight of the Double Eagle Award

Purpose: It is the mission of the Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, SJ, to improve its members and enhance the communities in which they live, by teaching and emulating the principles of Brotherly Love, Tolerance, Charity and Truth, while actively embracing high social, moral and spiritual values including fellowship, compassion, dedication to God, family and country.

The Knight of the Double Eagle Award is meant to recognize those who exemplify the ideals of this mission statement through their pursuit of education for themselves and other Masons, and their service and support of, and participation within, their Valleys, Lodge(s), families, and communities.

Minimum Requirements: (145 earned points) Applicants must record activities in each of the four main categories for the award—education, service, participation, and support. The minimum points required per category are noted in each. The 10 points awarded for a miscellaneous task may be applied to any of the four required categories in lieu of satisfying a requirement within one of those required categories.

A completed application and supporting data must be submitted to the Knight of the Double Eagle program administrators Mark Cline 32° KCCH (ibemac03@gmail.com) or Rick LaGue 32° KCCH (rlague@hotmail.com) by October 1st each year to qualify. They will review applications and then submit them to the Personal Representative of the Cedar Rapids Valley for final approval. The award will be presented annually at the Fall Reunion to any valley member that satisfies its requirements.
