

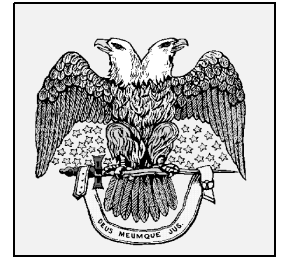

Easter Iowa Experiences 500 Year Flood

The good news is that the Cedar Rapids Scottish Rite Temple didn't suffer any direct physical damage from the epic flood that inundated eastern Iowa this Spring. We have done our part in assisting displaced community service organizations and performing arts groups and things are beginning to settle down but it will be quite awhile before things return to normal. There are numerous Brothers who suffered significant property losses. However despite scattered illness reports all seem to be in good health. It has been heart warming to hear all the reports of Brothers helping Brother.

The long term effect of the flood is that the Alliant Energy 6th Ave Generating Plant that supplied steam for heating our building was destroyed. Alliant has a temporary boiler in place to meet the heating needs for this upcoming heating season. That is the good news, the bad is that heating costs maybe as much as four times last years cost. Our monthly cost last year during the four month heating season was about \$2000/ month. Cost this year could reach \$8000/ month an annual increase of \$24,000 over last year and budget. Assistance is needed and expenses will need to be curtailed to meet this dilemma.

Scottish Rite Masonry has overcome challenges in the past and with the participation of membership, we will meet this test. Your patience, understanding and support will help maintain your Scottish Rite. -James Burr Registrar
